1. What documents are required to be submitted for admission?

To apply for the BCA program, you will need to provide colour scans of the following original documents:

- Grade sheet of Class 10
- Grade sheet of Class 12
- Aadhar Card for Indian Nationals or Passport for Foreign Nationals

These documents need to be uploaded onto the admissions portal as part of the application process.

2. Is the Online Program recognized?

3. Is the degree acquired through an online mode equivalent to an on-campus mode of learning?
